

## Highlights of the Recent Uniform Changes Approved by the PIAA Board of Directors

- The following officials' uniform changes were approved at the July Board of Directors meeting:
  - o Field Hockey officials may now wear a long or short sleeved neon yellow jersey.
  - Football officials may now wear a jersey with stripes between 1" and 2 ¼ inches wide.
  - o Soccer officials may now wear a long or short sleeved pro style black shirt.
  - o Volleyball officials may now wear an all-white collared short sleeved shirt.
  - Wrestling officials may now wear a gray shirt with black pinstripes.
- Officials may also now have white accent markings on their shoes. These markings do not include the outside sole of the shoe and are primarily the manufacturer logos.
- Officials are permitted to wear shorts for sub-varsity football contests.
- All officials must dress alike.
- Athletic Directors are requested to report to PIAA any instances whereby officials are not in uniform.

## Clarifying Information Regarding Officials' Uniform Shoes White on the outside of the soles is not permitted.
