#### **Board of Directors' Meeting Update**

The PIAA Board of Director's held a board meeting on July 14th, 2021. Some important items that passed were changes to the glossary for date of transfer, open gym, and practice. There were also five updates passed on suspended protocol, and effective immediately. Three of those updates effect Article VI, Transfer, Residence and Recruiting: Post-Season Eligibility; one to Article III, Attendance, Cooperative Sponsorships and one to Rules and Regulations on Heat Acclimatization for football. The Board also approved for Volleyball that teams will remain on the same bench and playing areas throughout the match. There were also six items approved on a first reading. ## Reminder to Member Schools

As a reminder to Athletic Administrators, as PIAA is the registry for sports officials, it is the responsibility of schools to make sure officials are properly registered with the PIAA, including having three background clearances. PIAA member school administrators can check individual officials by logging in with their school access code and under the Account Tools menu click View Officials' Directory.

#### View Coaches Directory

Lookup coaches affiliated with your school.

#### View Disqualification Reports

reports of sport disqualifications.

#### View Officials Directory

Lookup officials in your arga by sport or name


Once in the Officials' Directory schools can search individual officials. Any officials who can not be found in the registry are not properly registered with the PIAA and should not officiate at your school.

#### 2021-2022 Mandatory Rules Interpretation Meetings for Coaches

As stated in the PIAA By-Laws, the Head Coach of each PIAA senior high school team must attend at least one PIAA mandatory rules interpretation meeting each year for each boys' and girls' sport listed (Fall: Field Hockey, Football, Soccer, & Volleyball(Boys' & Girls') Please Note: Boy's Volleyball Rule Interpretation Meetings need to be attended in the Fall; Winter: Basketball, Swimming & Diving, & Wrestling, Spring: Baseball, Lacrosse, Softball, Track & Field ). The rules interpretation meetings will be available through zoom or in-person and conducted by local officials' chapters.

Schools whose coaches are not recorded as attending will be fined \$100.00 per sport.


