Official Fall Appreciation Week: October 2nd-8th, 2022

PIAA is proud to announce it will once again celebrate PIAA Officials during three different weeks throughout the fall, winter, and spring sport seasons. Next week will kick-off the first appreciation week for Fall Officials': October 2nd—8th. Winter Officials' Appreciation week will be January 8th—14th and Spring Officials' Appreciation Week will be April 2nd—8th. We request our member schools to participate and show appreciation to our officials during these highlighted weeks.

In an effort to assist PIAA member schools, PIAA has provided a list of items that schools may want to consider during these Appreciation Weeks.

Items for Consideration to Promote PIAA Officials' Appreciation Weeks:

- Make Officials' Appreciation Week announcements at the beginning of the school day.
- Publish Officials' Appreciation Week in school related newsletters/websites.
- Post on school marquee in front of the school welcoming officials to campus.
- Use the hashtag #ThankYouOfficials when posting to school social media accounts.
- Introduce and thank officials prior to contest starting.
- Have student-athletes individually thank each official.
- Have a student-athlete read the pre-contest sportsmanship information and welcome officials.
- Recognize graduates from your school on social media who have become officials.
- Designate a student or parent to be the official(s) escort while on campus.
- Designate a student or parent to greet the official(s) upon arrival at your school.
- Provide parking spaces, water, Gatorade, towel, snacks, etc.
- Invite officials' spouses to the game and provide complimentary seating.
- Contact local media to do a story on Officials' Appreciation Week.
- Officials' appreciation week banners and signage on the fence, wall, etc., surrounding the contest playing area.
- Gift cards/cookies/donuts/other items presented to the crew by both the home and visiting team.
- Photos of the officiating crew with both teams and coaches prior to the start of the game (or at the end, depending on timing).
- Read a PSA at the start of the game, thanking the crew for working the contest.
- "Thank you" cards, signed by the team and coaching staff.
- Special appreciation signage in the officials' locker room.
- Recorded "thank you" messages from student-athletes and coaches to officials, posted on social media.
