## IX. Proposed Constitution Amendment(s)

 On a second reading basis, from the PIAA Strategic Planning Committee, to add language to the PIAA Constitution, ARTICLE V, ORGANIZATION AND AUTHORITY, Section 1. Pennsylvania Interscholastic Athletic Association, Inc. (PIAA) Districts, to read as follows;

### ARTICLE V Section 1. Pennsylvania Interscholastic Athletic Association, Inc. (PIAA) Districts

Teams from member schools are eligible to participate in PIAA District Championship tournaments and Contests only in the PIAA District in which they are located under this Section or, if they have transferred Districts under Section 2 of this ARTICLE, in the PIAA District to which they have transferred.

2. On a **third and final reading basis**, from the PIAA Strategic Planning Committee, to modify language to the PIAA Constitution, ARTICLE IX, DISTRICT COMMITTEES, Section 1. B., Method of Selection, to read as follows;

## ARTICLE IX, DISTRICT COMMITTEES, Section 1. B., Method of Selection

The PIAA member schools of a District shall elect each year from their own District, at their annual meeting, members <u>of their District Committee</u>, to serve for one year except the junior high/middle schools' representative <u>and elected male and female officials'</u> representatives, who shall serve for a period of two years, starting the following July 1.

# X. Proposed Bylaw Amendment(s)

Dr. Lombardi

1. On a **second reading basis**, from the PIAA Strategic Planning Committee, to amend ARTICLE VIII, PERIOD OF PARTICIPATION, Section 1, Period of Participation and INTERPRETATION of the PIAA Bylaws to read as follows;

# ARTICLE VIII, PERIOD OF PARTICIPATION, Section 1, Period of Participation and INTERPRETATION

A student may not represent the student's school in interscholastic athletics if the student has:

**A.** Reached the end of the student's fourth consecutive year (8th consecutive semester or the equivalent) beyond the 8th grade year, without regard to the student's period of attendance;

**B.** Participated in six seasons beyond the sixth grade or four seasons beyond the eighth grade in any sport; or

**C.** Completed the work credit requirements for completion of grades nine, ten, eleven and twelve, inclusive.

# INTERPRETATION

# Section 1. October 5, 2016.

The number of semesters to be counted under Section 1A is not triggered until the student <u>has completed the credit requirements for completion of the 8<sup>th</sup> grade and has</u> <u>been identified by their school for promotion</u> enrolls in and attends 9<sup>th</sup> grade. <u>A repeat of</u> <u>8th grade after successful completion of the credits requirements or meeting the school's</u>

promotional requirements, will trigger the start of the student's eight consecutive semesters of eligibility. The number of seasons to be counted under Section 1B is triggered at the beginning of the student's 7<sup>th</sup> grade year. In calculating semesters, as well as seasons played, under this Section, enrollment and participation at any school, not just a PIAA member school, are included in making such determinations.

2. On a **second reading basis**, an amendment to ARTICLE XIX, JUNIOR HIGH/ MIDDLE SCHOOLS, Section 6. Contest Rules Standards for Junior High/Middle Schools Interscholastic Athletic Competition of the PIAA Bylaws.

ARTICLE XIX, JUNIOR HIGH/MIDDLE SCHOOLS, Section 6, (screen share) Contest Rules Standards for Junior High/Middle Schools Interscholastic Competition;

3. On a **second reading basis**, an amendment to Article XIII, Section 8, A, & B, of the PIAA Bylaws, to replace existing language with the following:

## ARTICLE XIII, Section 8, A. & B.

#### A. Mandatory Disqualification. One Game Suspension.

Any Coach, team personnel and/or contestant who, is ejected from a scrimmage, interschool practice, or a contest by a state high school association recognized and/or registered official in that sport for unsportsmanlike conduct or flagrant misconduct is disqualified from Coaching and/or participating for the remainder of the day and in all Contests on the next Contest day of the same level (varsity, junior varsity, or otherwise) of competition from which the Coach and/or contestant was previously disqualified. For a Coach, participation in the next Contest includes any contact by the Coach with members of the Team, including other Coaches, between the time that the Team arrives at the Contest site and the conclusion of the last Contest of the day. The Principal must direct the Coach not to attend all of the Contest(s).

**B.** Supplemental Disqualification. Two Game Suspension. Any Coach, team personnel and/or contestant who, is ejected from a scrimmage, interschool practice, or a contest by a state high school association recognized and/or registered official and a component of the ejection is any of the following actions: confronting an official, coach, or contestant; physically contacting an official, coach, or contestant; directing foul or vulgar language/gestures toward an official, coach, contestant or spectator(s); using ethnic or racially insensitive comments: will be disqualified from coaching and/or participating for the remainder of the day and for the next two (2) Contests including all Contests on the next two (2) Contest days of the same level (varsity, junior varsity, or otherwise) of competition from which the Coach, team personnel and/or contestant was previously disqualified. For the purposes of this provision, the jurisdiction of the official(s) to apply and enforce this rule begins upon the official's arrival at the Contest site and ends when the official (or the last of the team of officials) leaves the Contest site. The Contest site is defined as premises on which the competition surface is located and includes the entirety of the premises and parking areas.

4. On a **second reading basis**, to add language to ARTICLE XIII, Section 9., Violations, by Individuals, of the PIAA Bylaws to read as follows;

## **ARTICLE XIII, PENALTIES, Section 9, Violations by Individuals**

The development of a procedure for District Committees to request, in writing, an investigation by the school principal and a written report to be submitted to the District Committee for the District Committee's review regarding egregious supplemental disgualifications of players, coaches, team personnel.

# XI. Proposed PIAA Policies & Procedures Amendment(s) Dr. Lombardi

1. On a **second reading basis**, amend language to the PIAA Emerging Sports Process Guide in the PIAA Policies & Procedures, to read as follows;

## PIAA Emerging Sports Process Guide Application Process:

Application Process:

An applicant must submit an application and <u>supporting <del>supplemental</del> materials to PIAA.</u>

<u>The PIAA Executive Staff will conduct an initial review of the application and will arrange</u> for the application to be presented presents information to the PIAA Board of Directors at <u>a atheir next</u> regularly scheduled meeting. <del>unless the meeting is scheduled within 30 days</del> of receipt of the application. <u>The applicant will be given the opportunity to make the request</u> to the Board of Directors.

#### Board completes review of application.

<u>The application will be approved if the Board of Directors, at three separate meetings, votes</u> to approve it. The final vote requires a favorable vote of 2/3 of those Board members in attendance and voting. If the application is rejected in any of these votes, it may not be presented for approval again for a period of one year from the date of rejection. Executive Staff sends a summary of preliminary findings to the applicant. The summary of findings may include an invitation for the applicant to attend the Board of Directors' next meeting.

Board makes final decision during the third meeting that the application is being considered by the Board of Directors. If invited, the applicant may attend the meeting to discuss in detail the application and the applicant sport's viability as an emerging sport.

Following action by the Board of Directors, applicant receives final decision, including whether the Board will recommend the applicant sport by added as an emerging sport for the following school year.

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Application Reconsideration:

Applicants may request reconsideration of a Board of Directors' decision only if new information is presented that was not reasonably available at the time of the original decision. Reconsideration may be requested by emailing or mailing a letter to the Board of Directors via PIAA staff within 30 calendar days from the time a written decision is sent to applicants. An explanation must be submitted to clarify the reasons the new information was not originally available. Any additional or repetitive information that was originally available to the Board may not be submitted for reconsideration.
