William Pfeifer Named NFHS Girls Soccer National Coach of the Year: Twelve PA Coaches Receive NFHS Sectional Coach of the Year Honors

William Pfeifer (Moon Township HS) has been named National Girls Soccer Coach of the Year for the 2021-2022 season by the NFHS (National Federation of High School Associations) Coaches Association. With 482 victories Pfeifer has the most wins in Pennsylvania girls soccer history.



In addition to Pfeifer, eleven Pennsylvania Coaches have been named NFHS Sectional Coaches of the Year. The NFHS is divided into eight

geographical sections. Pennsylvania is a member of Section 2 – Mideast (DE, DC, KY, MD, OH, PA, VA, WV).
