23rd ANNUAL PIAA BOYS' TEAM TENNIS CHAMPIONSHIPS

MECHANICSBURG - The 2024 PIAA Boys' Team Tennis Championships took to the courts at the Hershey Racquet Club in Hershey, Pa. Teams competed two straight days, Friday, May 17th and Saturday, May 18th, in Chocolatetown to crown two PIAA Boys' Team Tennis Champions.

The 3A championship match was the first on the courts. Once again, it was two familiar District I foes competing against each other for the title. Conestoga HS and Lower Merion HS have split the last three championships. Lower Merion won consecutive titles in 2021-22, while Conestoga are the defending champions, winning in 2023. This is the third year in a row these two teams are facing each other in the PIAA finals.

Both teams shared similar results playing their way through the championship bracket. Lower Merion was the number one seed at the top of the 3A bracket and won 13 straight matches to get to the finals. Conestoga was the second seed out of District I. Conestoga also won 13 straight matches to get to the finals.

This championship match lasted nearly two hours. In the end, Conestoga took the final match on the court, the 1 Doubles. Conestoga won its fifth overall title, defending their title and winning back-to-back 3A PIAA Boys' Team Tennis Championships.



Conestoga HS wins back-to-back 3A Boys' Tennis Team Titles.


In the 2A championship, the finals were between the number one seed from District III, Lancaster Country Day HS, and the number one seed from District X, Cathedral Prep HS. Lancaster County Day came into the Team Championships as the 2A defending champion, winning the title in 2023, making their third consecutive team final. Lancaster Country Day was 11-1 in the championship bracket.

Cathedral Prep was making their first team finals appearance. Prep had a record of 10-3 in the PIAA Championship bracket.

The final match on the court was also played for nearly two hours. Lancaster Country Day came out on top for the win, defending their title and winning back-to-back 3A PIAA Boys' Team Tennis Championships.
