Member Schools showed their overwhelming support for Fall Sports Officials' on October 6th through the 12th but that's just the first of three Officials' Appreciation Weeks. The Winter Sports Officials' Appreciation Week is scheduled to kick off this Sunday, January 12-18, 2025. Spring Sports Officials' will be recognized April 6-12, 2025.

Their unwavering efforts do not get the well deserved appreciation for all they do for Pennsylvania student-athletes. This is a time to celebrate and thank officials for their tireless efforts."
