PIAA Announces New Staff

PIAA welcomes two new support staff

MECHANICSBURG, PA – The Pennsylvania Interscholastic Athletic Association, Inc. (PIAA) is pleased to announce the hiring of two new support staff, Campbell May and Myneisha Ford, as well as the promotion of Alex Mykut to Director of Officials and Sport.

Mykut began his tenure with the PIAA in December 2023 as the Officials' Administrator, following an internship with the organization during the fall of 2023. During his first six months on staff, Mykut balanced his role at the PIAA while completing the final semester of his master's degree in Sport Management at Millersville University and competing as a Division II baseball student-athlete for the Marauders. In January 2026, he was promoted to lead the PIAA Officials Department. A graduate of Huntingdon High School in PIAA District VI, Mykut was a three-sport student-athlete in baseball, football, and wrestling.



Myneisha Ford was hired in January 2026 as the Officials' Administrator. Her



responsibilities include corresponding with officials' chapters and registered officials, verifying and recording background clearances, maintaining the officials' registration database, and assisting with officials' assignments and the PIAA Officials Convention. Ford earned a Bachelor of Arts in Sport Management with a minor in Business Management from Marshall University in December 2023. While at Marshall, she worked for three years as the Thundering Herd football equipment manager, supporting team operations through

gameday preparation, practice organization, equipment distribution, and assisting

quarterbacks during 7-on-7 sessions. Most recently, Ford worked at Milton Hershey School.

Campbell May was hired in October 2025 as the Member School's Administrator and Receptionist. Her daily responsibilities include managing direct telephone inquiries, assisting member schools with data reporting and collection, coordinating tournament sanctioning and cooperative sponsorships, and handling media inquiries. May earned a Bachelor of Science in Sport Management with a minor in Business from Mount St. Mary's University in May 2025. From August 2024 to May 2025, she served as an Athletic Operations Intern in the Mount's Athletics Department and spent one season as the men's basketball manager. A 2021 graduate of Trinity High School in PIAA District III, May was also a boys basketball manager for three seasons.
